SCHOLARSHIP & BURSARY

DEFINITION:

Scholarship & Bursary: A financial contribution to assist eligible Moose Cree First Nation post-secondary students who meet the established criteria listed.

ELIGIBILITY:

- Must be a registered Moose Cree First Nation member,
- Enrolled full time as a continuing student in an accredited post-secondary institution.

CRITERIA:

- You are required to provide the following;
 - i) copy of an official transcript indicating full time enrollment and satisfactory academic standing *(GPA 2.0 or 60%)* for the Fall 2021 Semester (Sept.-Dec.) or
 - ii) if you provide copy of **unofficial** transcript, **it must be signed** and verified by a school official (academic advisor, counselor or registrar clerk)
 - iii) If your transcript provides marks for only half your courses with the remainder noted as In Progress with no marks, the courses provided with a mark, combined must total a **GPA of 2.0 or 60%** for the Fall 2021 Semester.
- Personal financial budget and monthly receipts.
- Letter describing your personal career aspirations.
- Must provide a reference letter supporting the following:
 - i) community involvement, extra-curricular,
 - ii) personal leadership,
 - iii) personal goals,
 - iv) attitude toward your studies, perseverance and/or endurance despite challenges.

• Submit completed MCEEF scholarship/bursary application form with supporting documents within deadline date.

APPLICATION DEADLINES:

Written notification will be sent to successful applicants within four weeks of deadline date.

SELECTION PROCEDURE:

Eligible and completed applications will be reviewed by the Moose Cree Education Enhancement Fund administrative staff before forwarding to the Selection Committee.

SCHOLARSHIP & BURSARY DISPERSEMENT/ACKNOWLEDGEMENT:

Scholarships & Bursaries shall be forwarded by x-press post mail to all successful applicants. At the Annual Moose Cree Education Authority, Post-Secondary Student Awards Banquet in Moose Factory, a listing of the successful applicants will be acknowledged.

HOW TO APPLY:

Applicants must complete the application form with <u>ALL</u> supporting documents. Applications must be submitted to MCEEF by 4:00 p.m. on Friday, May 27, 2022.
